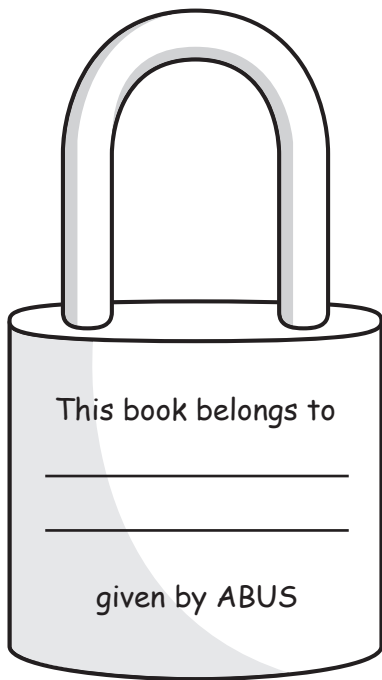

Dad was wandering across the garden, staring intently at his tablet.

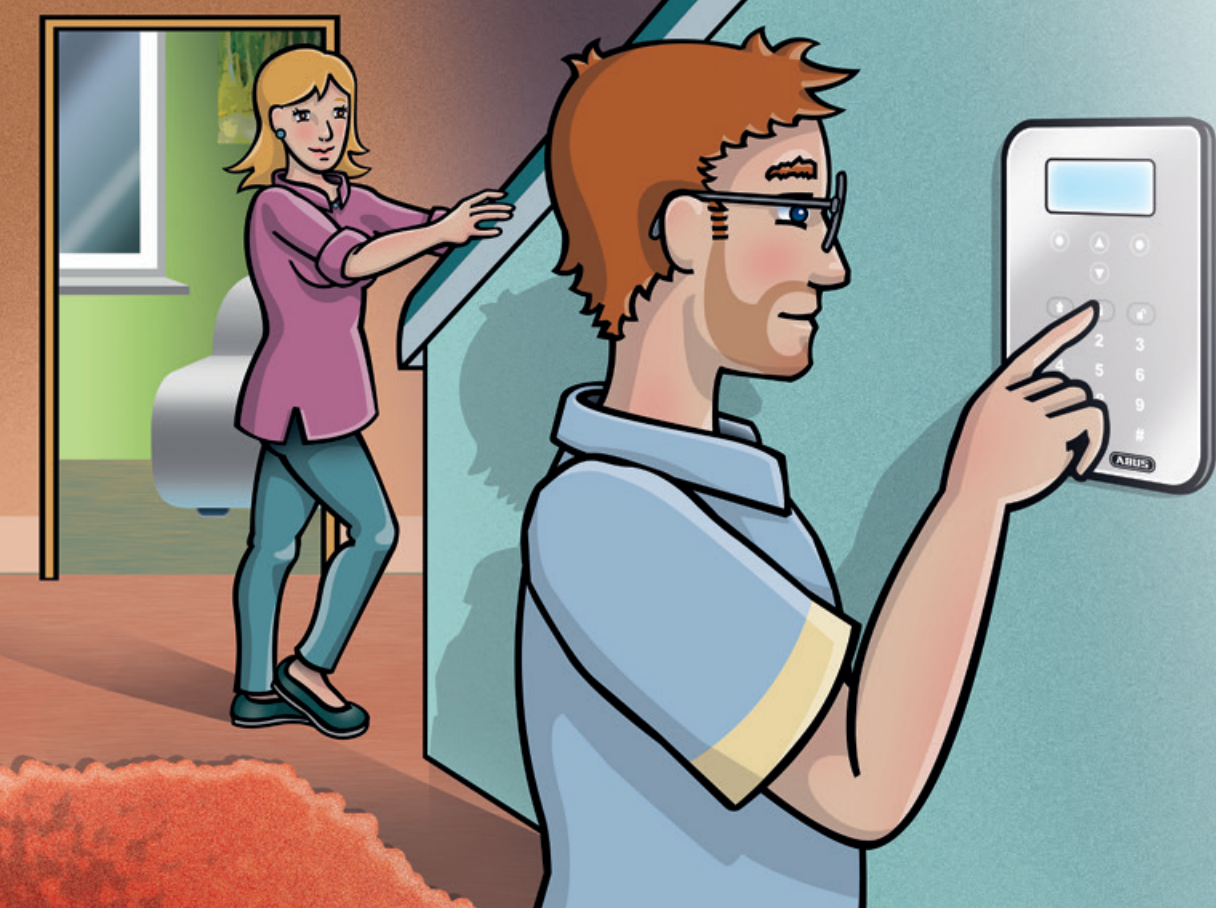
He was checking if he could see video images of the living room on the screen while he was away.

»And a window that is slightly open, is still an open window!« Mum added. »I'll go and close it immediately.«

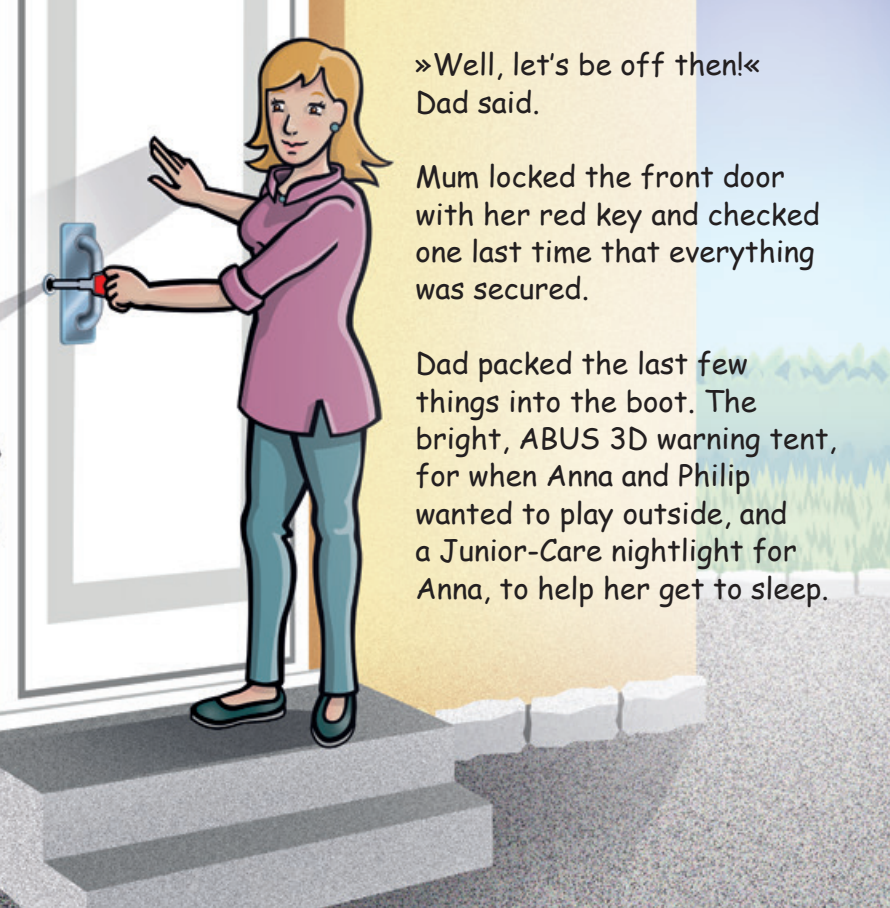
Afterwards, Dad set the ABUS alarm security system so that the house was protected.

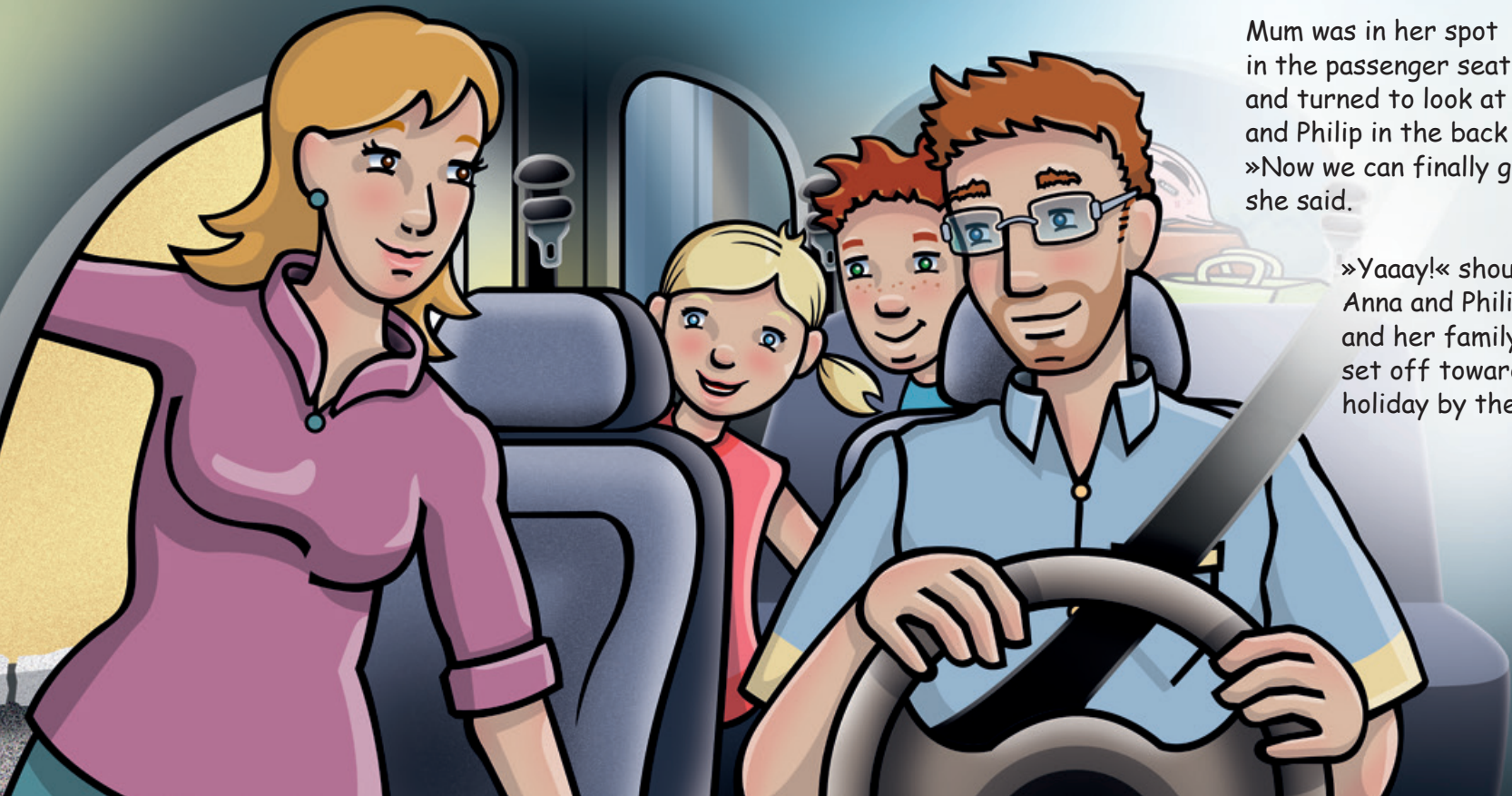


»Well, let's be off then!«

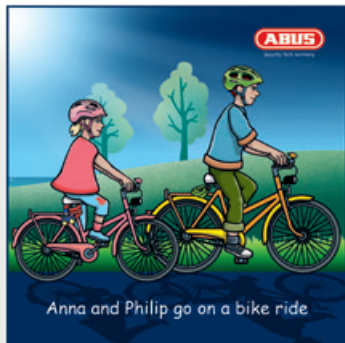
